In consideration for the right to bowl in this 14<sup>th</sup> Annual Pikes Peak USBC Senior Master's Tournament, I agree to the following conditions.

1. To abide by all the rules and regulations of the USBC, and such rules as published for this tournament. I am 50 years of age or older and a USBC member with a minimum 190 book average for 21 games or more for the prior season or the current season.
2. Entry fee is \$100.00, there will be at least one prize for each 6 entries, and the prize fund is returned 100%. The Pikes Peak USBC Association shall not be liable to refund my entry fee if I do not take part in this tournament through no fault or negligence of the association.
3. The only sums to which I shall be entitled for bowling in this tournament are those prizes or awards that may be won by me in this tournament. Should the winner of this tournament be unable to compete in the 2010 USBC Senior Master's Tournament, the Pikes Peak USBC Association shall pay the \$400 USBC Senior Master's Tournament entry fee for the next eligible competitor.
4. Headgear shall not be allowed. Shirts must have a collar. Failure to adhere to this rule will result in disqualification and forfeiture of entry fees.
5. Lane assignment will be determined by the Pikes Peak USBC Association Tournament Manager. Prior to the qualifying round, bowlers will be allowed ten minutes of practice. Every ball used during this tournament must be listed on the score sheets. All bowling balls used by the entrants may be weighed. Any illegal ball will be cause for disqualification and forfeiture of entry fees. If a bowler arrives late and still wants to participate, he may do so by accepting zero score for the frames already bowled.
6. The total pin count from the qualifying round of eight games will determine the eight finalists that advance to round-robin play. A tie for the eighth round-robin place will be broken by bowling a complete game. If this game results in another tie, one frame matches will be bowled until the tie is broken. Pin count resulting from tie breaking game/frames do not carry over to round-robin finals.
7. The lanes will not be cleaned and oiled after the qualifying round. There will be no practice prior to round-robin play or the final position round.
8. The number of bowlers qualifying for round-robin play will be determined by the total number of entries (maximum of 8). Round-robin bowlers will be seeded based on their scores from the qualifying round. Round-robin play will be a one game match between each bowler followed by a final position round. The winner of a match will receive 30 bonus pins and the loser will receive zero pins. In the case of a tie, each bowler will receive 15 bonus pins.
9. The winner is the bowler with the highest total pin count from the eight qualifying games, the seven round-robin games, the final position round, and all bonus pins.
