## PIKES PEAK USBC OPEN TOURNAMENT RULES

**VEHICLES ENTERING THE ACADEMY WITHOUT A MILITARY ID MUST HAVE VALID DRIVERS LICENSE, PROOF OF INSURANCE AND REGISTRATION. TO GAIN ENTRANCE, I MUST PROVIDE A LIST OF BOWLERS TO THE GATE. I WILL NEED THEIR DRIVERS LICENSE NUMBER AND STATE IF NOT COLORADO AND THEIR DATE OF BIRTH.**

1. Open to all adult members living within the jurisdiction of, or who are members of the Pikes Peak USBC. ALL BOWLERS MUST HAVE A CURRENT USBC MEMBERSHIP. Bowlers who live within the jurisdiction of Pikes Peak USBC, and are not members of another association, may enter this tournament by paying an associate fee of \$18.00. USBC Rule #13 (Parental Consent) does apply to this tournament.
2. DRESS CODE: No cutoffs, tank tops, muscle shirts, shirts with offensive language/pictures or bare midriffs will be allowed. PENALTY: Disqualification and forfeiture of all entry fees and prizes.
3. A team shall consist of no more than two (2) members classified as professional bowlers (in the five-member team event) and not more than one (1) on a doubles team.
4. HANDICAP shall be based on 90% of 230. Scratch division will bowl scratch.
5. Entry fee is \$20.00 per bowler, per event (handicap or scratch). A bowler may enter both the handicap and scratch division for \$30.00 per event. Entry fee for all events is \$5.00 for scratch and \$5.00 for handicap.
6. First place winners in each event will receive trophies as determined by the tournament committee. The same team or individual may win handicap and scratch awards
7. MULTIPLE PARTICIPATION: BOWLERS MAY PARTICIPATE MORE THAN ONCE IN EACH EVENT. TEAM EVENT: No more than three bowlers may participate together on multiple teams. BOWLERS MAY PARTICIPATE MORE THAN ONCE IN DOUBLES AND SINGLES. Partners must be different each time. When a bowler enters multiple events, the first series in each event will count toward the all event score. BOWLERS MUST ENTER BOTH DOUBLES AND SINGLES. Doubles will be bowled first. Individual bowlers may cash only once in the top ten in the singles category.
8. AVERAGES: Use the highest average of 21 games or more, from the 2010-2011 year book. If no 2010-2011 yearbook average, bowler may use the highest 2011 certified summer league average of 21 games or more. The summer average must be on file at the Pikes Peak USBC office. If a bowler has neither of the above averages, use the highest current average of 21 games or more as of January 27, 2012 in a PPUSBC certified league. The league secretary must verify this current average. If a bowler does not meet this average requirement, they must bowl using an average of 230.
9. The Team Captain is responsible for the submission of each entry and all fees. Entry forms must be COMPLETELY filled out as required, to include, the Team Name, signed by the Team Captain, with entry fees attached, or the entry will not be accepted. The Team Captain is responsible for the appearance of the team at the time and date scheduled to bowl. Failure to appear as scheduled will result in forfeiture of entry fees.
10. It shall be the bowler's responsibility to verify the accuracy of their average, whether submitted by the bowler, the Team Captain, or others. Failure to use proper average, or make a correction prior to or at the time of bowling, shall disqualify the score if the submitted average is lower than the actual average. Winnings will be based on the submitted average if it is higher than the actual average and not corrected prior to bowling.
11. Corrections in average may be made, up to the completion of the first game of a series, or within 48 hours after completion of a series, if the tournament manager has given written consent to the bowler prior to completion of the first game of a series authorizing such extension.
12. USBC Rule 319a Paragraph #2 does not apply to this tournament. USBC Rule 319d (reporting winnings over \$600.00) does not apply.
13. USBC RULE 319e DOES APPLY. (See page 86 of USBC Rules. This rule applies to average adjustment for tournament performance during the last 12 months)
14. The Tournament Manager makes lane assignments. Additional squads may be added prior to January 28, 2012. If it becomes necessary to reschedule bowlers in any event, it will be done at the discretion of the Tournament Manager. In the case of a machine failure and it becomes impossible to complete the event within the scheduled time, the event will be rescheduled and bowling will resume at the point where bowling was discontinued.
15. No line-up changes will be allowed after submission of entry. Substitutes will take the position of the bowler they are replacing.
16. Tardy players will start in the frame being bowled when they are READY for tournament play, with no score for frames missed. USBC Rule 322 does apply. **PACERS ARE NOT ALLOWED!**
17. Score Sheets – After a score sheet has been signed by the contestant or Team Captain, it cannot be changed except in the case of an obvious error in scoring or calculation. Bowlers are cautioned to sign the score sheets only after ensuring the scores and calculations are correct. Duplicate recap sheets are available for the bowlers. Computer printouts will be the Official score sheet. These will be on file for 72 hours.
18. TEAM CAPTAINS are the team representative and will serve in all matters pertaining to individual behavior and compliance with Tournament and USBC Rules. The team captain will be responsible to the Tournament Manager for the conduct of their team members throughout the times they are on the lanes in competition.
19. **USBC RULES WILL APPLY IN ALL INSTANCES NOT SPECIFICALLY COVERED BY THE ABOVE RULES!**
