RULES, REGULATIONS AND GENERAL INFORMATION

1. The 2012 Colorado Springs Queens Tournament, supported by the Pikes Peak USBC, is an individual, USBC certified, scratch, double-elimination, match-game tournament. All participants must be female and have a current USBC adult membership and understand they are competing in a scratch tournament.
2. Entry fee is \$85 for entries received by Saturday, February 25th. Entry fee is \$100 (cash only) for walk-in entries (\$10 of the \$15 late fee will be placed in the prize fund and \$5 will be go to tournament expenses). Entries close 8:30 am February 26, 2012. Entry form and fee must be **received** by February 18th in order to be placed in the early entry cash drawing. Drawing will be held prior to the start of the 6-game qualifying round. **No personal checks will be accepted after Feb 18th.**
3. Check-in for the tournament will begin at 8:15 am. A bowler arriving late will begin play and her score will count beginning with the frame being bowled.
4. Bowlers are requested to wear bowling shirts with their names on the back. Suitable bowling attire should be worn. No tank tops, crop tops, short shorts, short skirts, or leggings will be permitted.
5. Every ball used during competition must be listed on the score sheet. All bowling balls used by a bowler at any time are subject to being weighed. Any illegal ball will be cause for DISQUALIFICATION and FORFEITURE of entry fee.
6. Due to time constraints, one lane courtesy will be STRICTLY enforced.
7. *Qualifying Competition Round:*
 - Qualifying Round will consist of 6 games. Lane assignments will be drawn at check-in.
 - Bowlers will be allowed 10 minutes of practice on their starting lanes.
 - Total pins will determine the eight (8) bowlers who will qualify for the match play final round.
 - If a tie occurs for 8th place, bowlers shall compete in a 9th and 10th frame roll-off on a pair designated by the Tournament Director. The bowler with the highest single game will select her starting lane. The bowler on the odd lane will start the roll-off. If a tie still exists, bowlers will alternate lanes in a best ball roll-off until the tie is broken. Failure of any bowler to remain available in case of a tie will constitute a forfeit.
 - In the event of a tie for any other position, the bowler with the highest single qualifying game will be the higher seed. If necessary, the second high qualifying game will be used, and so on down until the tie is broken.
8. *Match-Play Round:*
 - Lane pairings will be as follows: #1 seed vs. #8 seed; #2 seed vs. #7 seed; #3 vs. #6 seed; #4 vs. #5 seed.
 - Bowlers will be allowed 5 minutes of practice prior to their first match. Match-play finals will begin immediately upon lane assignments and as soon as bowlers are set.
 - The higher seeded bowler will be allowed to select her starting lane at the beginning of each match. The bowler assigned to left lane will bowl her first frame. The bowler on the right will bowl the next two frames following match play procedures.
 - Two-game double-elimination bracket format will be used. All bowlers will begin in the WINNERS BRACKET. After losing one match, the bowler enters the CONTENDERS BRACKET. A player is eliminated after two losses.
 - In the event a bowler has earned a break during the competition, she will be entitled to ten minutes practice on a pair of lanes that is not scheduled for any future match.
 - If a tie occurs in the match play round, bowlers shall compete in a 9th and 10th frame roll-off. Each bowler will start on the lane where she finished the match. The bowler on the odd lane will start the roll-off. If a tie still exists, bowlers will alternate lanes in a best ball roll-off until the tie is broken. Failure of any bowler to remain available in case of a tie will constitute a forfeit.
9. All USBC Playing Rules and certified Colorado Springs Queens Rules will apply, unless otherwise stated. Tournament Management has the final authority to make decisions regarding anything not covered in these rules.
