

Adult All Star Selection Criteria

1. Bowlers selected to be a Pikes Peak All-Star will be based on the following criteria:
 - a. All eligible bowlers must have bowled in the Pikes Peak Association the year prior to making the team and the year they qualify for the team.
 - b. A bowler must bowl at least one league of 69 games or more in each of two different centers to be eligible for All-Star consideration.
 - c. A bowler must bowl a minimum of 150 games in league competition to be eligible for All-Star consideration and must meet the following minimum average requirements: Male 210, Female 200, Sr. Male 200, Sr. Female 180, Youth Male 175, and Youth Female 150.
 - d. Only winter league scores will be used for All-Star team computations.
 - e. Only bowlers who meet the above criteria may earn points for All-Star Team Selection.
 - f. The travel league will be considered as a house when vying for All-Star points.
 - g. In the event that a House hosts only Senior bowlers (senior men only or senior women only), any points awarded for All-Star qualifications shall apply only to "Senior" All-Star qualification.
 - h. For All-Star Qualification, any scores bowled in a sport league will use the score qualifications in effect for "Seniors" when awarding points based on scores. Adjustment for average will be based on USBC rule 202, and individual's average will be the adjusted average.
2. Two sets of eligibility goals will apply to all bowlers:
 - a. Average based: Points will be awarded to those bowlers with averages in the top twenty, with at least 69 games or more at the two different centers.
 - b. Performance based. Points will be awarded based on calculations from a bowler achieving a set of performance standards.
3. Bowlers will be ranked in each system, and then this ranking will be combined for an overall score. The combined score will then be the ranking for the All-Star team.

EXAMPLE:

	Average based	Performance based	Total points ranking
Bowler 'A'	3 rd	7 th	10
Bowler 'B'	1 st	1 st	2
Bowler 'C'	4 th	3 rd	7
Bowler 'D'	6 th	2 nd	8
Bowler 'E'	5 th	6 th	11

Based on the above example the ranking would be: 1st = Bowler 'B', 2nd = Bowler 'C', 3rd = Bowler 'D', 4th = Bowler 'A' and 5th = Bowler 'E'.

4. In the event of a tie for total ranking, the tie would be broken based on the performance based scores.
5. The following is the criteria for each All-Star category. Men, Women, Senior Women, Senior Men.

Rules for All-Star Team Average Based Criteria

1. Leagues

- a. Points will be awarded to those bowlers with averages in the top twenty, with at least 69 games or more at two different centers.
- b. Seniors will only compete against seniors for All-Star Average points.
- c. The bowler will receive points based on the following system if the average ranks within the top 20 eligible averages for that center:

1 st – 76	2 nd – 66	3 rd – 61	4 th – 56	5 th – 51	6 th – 47	7 th – 43
8 th – 39	9 th – 35	10 th – 31	11 th – 28	12 th – 25	13 th – 22	14 th – 19
15 th – 16	16 th – 13	17 th – 10	18 th – 7	19 th – 4	20 th – 1	

- d. The above system will be applied to a bowlers 2nd eligible center.

2. Colorado Springs Bracketed Tournaments (Masters/Queens)

- a. Points will be awarded to eligible bowlers who qualify for the finals at the Colorado Springs Masters and Queens tournaments.
- b. Points will be awarded based on the following point distribution system. Awarded points will be based on actual position place.

1 st = 15	2 nd = 13	3 rd = 12	4 th = 11	5 th & 6 th = 10
7 th & 8 th = 8	9 th – 12 th = 6	13 th – 16 th = 5		

- c. The points for bowlers will be adjusted based on the number of entries. Whichever points are earned should be multiplied by a factor of the number of tournament entries divided by 50. At no time can awarded points exceed the above listed points
- d. Seniors competing for Senior All-Stars will only be awarded points for senior tournaments.
- e. Senior women will be awarded points for bowling in the Queens.

3. Colorado Springs Senior Masters Tournament

- a. Points will be awarded to eligible bowlers who qualify for the finals at the Colorado Springs Senior Masters tournament.
- b. Points will be awarded based on the following point distribution system. Awarded points will be based on actual position place. For tie positions, points will be combined and divided for those positions.

1 st – 15	2 nd – 13	3 rd – 12	4 th – 11	5 th – 10
6 th – 9	7 th – 8	8 th – 7		

- c. The points for bowlers will be adjusted based on the number of entries. Whichever points are earned should be multiplied by a factor of the number of

tournament entries divided by 50. At no time can awarded points exceed the above listed points

4. Pikes Peak City Tournaments

- a. Points will be awarded to eligible bowlers who finish in the top 10 in the Scratch Singles and Scratch All-Events divisions of the Pikes Peak City Tournaments based upon the following point distribution system. Points will be awarded based on actual finishing position.

1 st - 10	2 nd - 9	3 rd - 8	4 th - 7	5 th - 6
6 th - 5	7 th - 4	8 th - 3	9 th - 2	10 th - 1

Rules for Men's All-Star Performance Criteria

1. The top 40 bowlers based on **Average Criteria Ranking** will be eligible for All-Star consideration.
 2. The following steps are used to calculate a base figure:
 - a. Compute the sum of all series 700 or higher and all games 275 or higher.
 - b. Divide this sum by the total of all league games bowled. This includes leagues with less than 21 games bowled.
 - c. Multiply the answer by 15. This is the base figure.
 3. Other points to be added to the base figure are:
 - a. Each 300 game 100 pts
 - b. Each 299 game 50 pts
 - c. Each 298 game 25 pts
 - d. Each 275-297 game 10 pts
 - e. Each 800 series 200 pts, plus 1 point for each pin over 800
 - f. Each 750-799 series 50 pts
 - g. Each 700-749 series 25 pts
 - h. High Center Average:
 - i. First 250 pts
 - ii. Second 150 pts
 - iii. Third 100 pts
 - i. Each Qualifying Average (69 games or more):
 - i. 240 or over 100 pts
 - ii. 230 or over 75 pts
 - iii. 220 or over 50 pts
 - j. Composite Average:
 - i. Each pin over 220, add 10 pts
 - ii. Each pin under 220, subtract 10 pts

Rules for Women's All-Star Performance Criteria

1. The top 40 bowlers based on **Average Criteria Ranking** will be eligible for All-Star consideration.
 2. The following steps are used to calculate a base figure:
 - a. Compute the sum of all series 650 or higher and all games 250 or higher.
 - b. Divide this sum by the total of all league games bowled. This includes leagues with less than 21 games bowled.
 - c. Multiply the answer by 8. This is the base figure.
 3. Other points to be added to the base figure are:
 - a. Each 300 game 100 pts
 - b. Each 299 game 50 pts
 - c. Each 298 game 25 pts
 - d. Each 275-297 game 20 pts
 - e. Each 250-274 game 10 pts
 - f. Each 800 series 200 pts, plus 1 point for each pin over 800
 - g. Each 750-799 series 50 pts
 - h. Each 700-749 series 30 pts
 - i. Each 675-699 series 20 pts
 - j. Each 650-674 series 10 pts
 - k. High Center Average:
 - i. First 250 pts
 - ii. Second 150 pts
 - iii. Third 100 pts
 - l. Each Qualifying Average (69 games or more):
 - i. 230 or over 100 pts
 - ii. 220 or over 75 pts
 - iii. 210 or over 50 pts
 - iv. 200 or over 25 pts
 - m. Composite Average:
 - i. Each pin over 200, add 5 pts
 - ii. Each pin under 200, subtract 5 pts

Rules for Senior Women's All-Star Performance Criteria

1. A bowler must be 55 years of age or older on August 1st to be eligible for Senior All-Star consideration.
 2. A senior bowler who qualifies for the regular All-Star Team is not eligible for the Senior All-Star Team for that season.
 3. The top 20 bowlers based on **Average Criteria Ranking** will be eligible for All-Star consideration.
 4. The following steps are used to calculate a base figure:
 - a. Compute the sum of all series 600 or higher and all games 225 or higher.
 - b. Divide this sum by the total of all league games bowled. This includes leagues with less than 21 games bowled.
 - c. Multiply the answer by 8. This is the base figure.
 5. Other points to be added to the base figure are:
 - a. Each 300 game 100 pts
 - b. Each 299 game 50 pts
 - c. Each 298 game 25 pts
 - d. Each 275-297 game 20 pts
 - e. Each 225-274 game 10 pts
 - f. Each 800 series 200 pts, plus 1 point for each pin over 800
 - g. Each 750-799 series 50 pts
 - h. Each 700-749 series 30 pts
 - i. Each 600-699 series 25 pts
 - j. Each Qualifying Average (69 games or more):
 - i. 220 or over 100 pts
 - ii. 210 or over 75 pts
 - iii. 200 or over 50 pts
 - iv. 190 or over 25 pts
 - k. Composite Average:
 - i. Each pin over 180, add 5 pts
 - ii. Each pin under 180, subtract 5 pts

Rules For Senior Men's Performance Based Criteria

1. A bowler must be 55 years of age or older on August 1st to be eligible for Senior All-Star consideration.
 2. A senior bowler who qualifies for the regular All-Star Team is not eligible for the Senior All-Star Team for that season.
 3. The top 20 bowlers based on **Average Criteria Ranking** will be eligible for All-Star consideration.
 4. The following steps are used to calculate a base figure:
 - a. Compute the sum of all series 650 or higher and all games 250 or higher.
 - b. Divide this sum by the total of all league games bowled. This includes leagues with less than 21 games bowled.
 - c. Multiply the answer by 8. This is the base figure.
 5. Other points to be added to the base figure are:
 - a. Each 300 game 100 pts
 - b. Each 299 game 50 pts
 - c. Each 298 game 25 pts
 - d. Each 275-297 game 20 pts
 - e. Each 250-274 game 10 pts
 - f. Each 800 series 200 pts, plus 1 point for each pin over 800
 - g. Each 750-799 series 50 pts
 - h. Each 700-749 series 30 pts
 - i. Each 675-699 series 20 pts
 - j. Each 650-674 series 10 pts
 - k. Each Qualifying Average (69 games or more):
 - i. 230 or over 100 pts
 - ii. 220 or over 75 pts
 - iii. 210 or over 50 pts
 - iv. 200 or over 25 pts
 - l. Composite Average:
 - i. Each pin over 190, add 5 pts
 - ii. Each pin under 190, subtract 5 pts

Pikes Peak Youth All-Star Selection Criteria

1. All eligible bowlers must have bowled in the Pikes Peak Association the year prior to making the team and the year they qualify for the team.
 2. A youth bowler must be in a certified USBC Youth league.
 3. A youth bowler must bowl a minimum of 48 games in league competition and must meet the following minimum average requirements to be eligible for All-Star consideration:
Youth Male 175 and Youth Female 150
 4. Only winter league scores will be used for All-Star computation.
 5. The highest average for one league will be used for Youth All-star selection

All-Star Team code Of Conduct

The conduct of the PPUA All-Star Teams will be above reproach at all times, and any PPUA member who qualifies for the All-Star Team will abide by the following Code of Conduct:

1. Each PPUA All-Star team member is expected present a good example of fairness and sportsmanship at all times.
 2. Each PPUA All-Star team member is expected to follow the attire guidelines established by the All-Star Team when performing at an All-Star event.
 3. Each PPUA All-Star team member is expected participate in other activities other then tournaments and fundraisers, i.e. youth bowling, selling of 50/50 tickets for Make-A-Wish and acquisition of door prizes.
